



## **(XII) MANNER OF EXECUTION OF SUBSIDY PROGRAMMES**



## **RGGVY**

### **RAJIV GANDHI GRAMEEN VIDYUTIKARAN YOJANA (RGGVY)**

- ❖ Government of India introduced RGGVY Programme with an aim to provide access to electricity to all the rural households in the country.
- ❖ RGGVY programme was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, GoI on April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2005. REC was the Nodal Agency.

### **IMPLEMENTATION OF RGGVY IN 10<sup>TH</sup> & 11<sup>TH</sup> PLANS**

- ❖ Under RGGVY programme, 13,002 un-electrified habitations and 35,65,160 rural households including 26,65,142 BPL RHHs, were electrified in A.P. by incurring an expenditure of Rs.912 crores, out of which 90% of the project cost was the grant from the Govt of India..

### **RGGVY IN 12<sup>TH</sup> & 13<sup>TH</sup> PLANS**

- ❖ Ministry of Power, Government of India has approved the scheme for continuation of Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidyutikaran Yojana (RGGVY) in 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> Plans vide OM dated 02-09-2013 with a total outlay of Rs.35,447 crores.
- ❖ DISCOMs are gearing up for implementation of RGGVY in 12<sup>th</sup> Plan.

### **PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR 12<sup>TH</sup> PLAN**

- ❖ APSPDCL, APCPDCL & APNPDCL have uploaded required data in the RGGVY web-portal as per the guidelines in respect of 17 districts and finalised the DPRs for implementation of RGGVY in 12<sup>th</sup> Plan with an outlay of Rs.666.09 crores for electrification of 10.24 lakh BPL rural households with necessary infrastructure in 14,670 Nos. Villages.
- ❖ The above project proposals of DISCOMs were approved by the State-level Coordination Committee meeting held on 09-12-2013 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary to Govt, Government of Andhra Pradesh as a pre-requisite for seeking the sanction of the projects from REC.
- ❖ Project proposals in respect of balance 5 districts have also been finalized by APEPDCL with an outlay of Rs.121.30 Crore.
- ❖ Sanction of all the projects under RGGVY for 12<sup>th</sup> Plan, is expected from REC during the last quarter of the financial year 2013-14. Works are likely to be commenced from the financial year 2014-15.



- ❖ Off-grid Decentralised Distribution-cum-Generation (DDG) projects for electrification of 310 Nos. remote un-electrified habitations with solar panels under RGGVY, is under progress with an outlay of Rs.65.75 crores, which is programmed to be completed by December 2014.
- ❖ DISCOMs have also proposed for setting up of grid connected solar power plants with a capacity of 100.50 MW at an estimated cost of Rs.1048.77 crores at 234 Nos. existing 33/11 KV substations under RGGVY for 12<sup>th</sup> Plan subject to the detailed guidelines and eligibility, considering the rural areas which are not getting proper quantity as well as quality of power
