

**NOTE ON POWER SUPPLY POSITION AND  
DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAMMES FOR THE MONTH OF  
MARCH - 2020**

**POWER SUPPLY POSITION:**

- The average energy met during March 2020 is 184.88 MU as against 194.135 MU during the March 2019 registering a negative growth of 4.77 %.
- The average unrestricted demand during the above period is 184.88 MU as against 194.135 MU during the March 2019 registering a negative growth of 4.77 %..
- The peak demand met during March 2020 is 10207 MW as against 8984 MW during the March 2019 registering a positive growth of 13.61 %.
- The average energy met during February 2020 is 185.79 MU as against 173.79 MU during the February 2019 registering an increase of 6.78 %.
- The average unrestricted demand during the above period is 185.79 MU as against 173.79 MU during the February 2019 registering an increase of 6.78 %.
- The peak demand met during February 2020 is 9941 MW as against 8968 MW during the February 2019 registering a increase of 10.83%

**DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAMMES:-**

- **9 hours day time free power supply to Agriculture :-**  
Government of AP is committed to provide 9 Hours day time free power supply to the Agriculture sector. There are 18.72 lakhs agriculture services in the State of Andhra Pradesh. These services are fed through 6,663 feeders across the state. Out of 6,663 no. of feeders 5547 no. of feeders are capable of supplying 9 hrs day time supply with existing infrastructure. 1116 no. of feeders needs augmentation of infrastructure to cater the needs of supplying 9 hrs during daytime. This is being done on war footing.
- High Voltage Distribution System (HVDS) is already implemented for 10,74089 pump-sets with a cost of Rs. 5075.52 Crores out of a total of 18.72 lakh agricultural pump sets existing in the state of Andhra Pradesh.
- Electrification of new housing colonies under INDIRAMMA housing Programme: Out of 1181 New Housing Colonies, 1175 new housing colonies have already been electrified and 6 Nos layouts not formed by Housing Depts.,
