

**NOTE ON POWER SUPPLY POSITION AND DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAMMES
FOR THE MONTH OF May - 2020**

POWER SUPPLY POSITION:

- The average energy met during May- 2020 is 178.77 MU as against 192.63 MU during May- 2019 registering a negative growth of 7.20 %.
- The average unrestricted demand during the above period is 178.95 MU as against 192.85 MU during May -2019 registering a negative growth of 7.21 %.
- The peak demand met during May- 2020 is 10101 MW as against 9854 MW during the May- 2019 registering a positive growth of 2.51%.
- The average energy met during April 2020 is 156.07 MU as against 188.05 MU during the April 2019 registering a negative growth of 17.01 %.
- The average unrestricted demand during the above period is 156.07 MU as against 188.05 MU during the April 2019 registering a negative growth of 17.01 %.
- The peak demand met during April 2020 is 8595 MW as against 9160 MW during the April 2019 registering a negative growth of 6.17 %.

DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAMMES:

a. **9 hours day time free power supply to Agriculture :-**

Government of AP is committed to provide 9 Hours day time free power supply to the Agriculture sector. There are 18.72 lakhs agriculture services in the State of Andhra Pradesh. These services are fed through 6,663 feeders across the state. Out of 6,663 no. of feeders 5616 no. of feeders are capable of supplying 9 hrs day time supply with existing infrastructure. 1047 no. of feeders needs augmentation of infrastructure to cater the needs of supplying 9 hrs during daytime. This is being done on war footing.

b. High Voltage Distribution System (HVDS) is already implemented for 10,74448 pump-sets with a cost of Rs. 5169.63 Crores out of a total of 18.72 lakh agricultural pump sets existing in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

c. Electrification of new housing colonies under INDIRAMMA housing Programme: Out of 1181 New Housing Colonies, 1175 new housing colonies have already been electrified and 6 Nos layouts not formed by Housing Depts.,
